The Mekong Princess is a modern steel hulled ship, hand-finished in brass and teak, constructed by highly skilled ship building craftsmen.

She embraces the classic 'French Colonial Era' in all fixtures and fittings. Mekong Princess is designed with an ultra-shallow draft, which enables her to navigate in very remote areas and shallow waterways.

Built in Saigon to international design and safety standards, Mekong Princess was launched in 2015 and is considered the best constructed and most elegant vessel plying the waters of the Mekong River today. The Mekong Princess with her 14 suites is purpose built for the areas they cruise through, and small enough to get under the bridges in Saigon to berth in the heart of the city, and to get into parts of the Mekong Delta not accessible to other river boats. With an average cruising speed of 8 knots (approximately 15km per hour) she affords a leisurely explore through a unique authentic part of the Mekong Delta.

DAY TWO ANGKOR BAN AND PHNOM PENH

Start today with a blessing ceremony by local monks and a visit to the authentic Cambodian village of Angkor Ban. The local children join the fun with a visit to the school.

Lunch is back onboard Mekong Princess as the ship sails towards the capital of Phnom Penh. Local cyclo drivers are waiting to take you for a ride through the busy streets to the Royal Palace and then on to the National Museum housing a treasure trove of ancient wonders from the Khmer Empire. Dinner is enhanced this evening with an Apsara dance performance.



This morning, travel by private motor-coach on a scenic 45-minute drive from the ship, arriving at Choeung Ek, "The Killing Fields" - the centre of the darkest days of Cambodian history. There is an opportunity to walk through the fields, visit the small museum and Memorial Stupa.

On return to Phnom Penh, you will visit the infamous S-21 - Tuol Sleng, a school turned into torture prison for enemies of the Khmer Rouge.

The afternoon is at leisure for you to explore Cambodia's capital city, Phnom Penh where the ship will be docked for an overnight stay.

Near the Cambodia-Vietnam border is the village of Hong Ngu. Your morning visit to the local weavers and artists in this rarely visited village is very welcome.

In the afternoon board sampans to Gieng Island to a local village then on to duck farms connected by monkey bridges and orchards along the riverside. Travel by trishaw to visit a Catholic church built around 1870.

The crew of Mekong Princess will assist with border crossing arrangements today before sailing to Hoa An for an overnight stay.

Wake to a sunrise at Hoa An village, known for flowers and crafts. See the gardens and meet the locals and learn about their daily lives.

Continue on by motor cart to another village and learn how conical hats and mats are woven. In the afternoon, the Mekong Princess will continue on

through the Mekong Delta to Can Tho, the capital city of the Mekong Delta region. Upon arrival, take a short orientation tour and then it's off to the Zihuang Pagoda (Chua Ong) where you are welcomed with a unicorn dance. The ship will be docked at Can Tho overnight.

DAY SIX CAN THO & BEN TRE

Before breakfast, board sampans for a cruise through the fascinating Cai Rang floating market near Can Tho. Watch as locals shop between boats for fresh fruits and vegetables enjoying a fresh coconut water drink. On the way back to Mekong Princess, stop at a local noodle factory to witness the ancient art of noodle making. Head back to the ship and then on to Ben Tre.

Take a sampan through mangrove lined channels to visit a local coconut candy maker - so delicious! Then walk through the village to visit an orchard where native fruits grow on vines. Taste a little yourself and then it's back to the pier where you board small local boats for a Nipah palm lined journey back to the ship. The Mekong Princess will sail on through the Bassac River to Ho Chi Minh City here it will dock overnight at Saigon Port.



DAY EIGHT HO CHI MINH

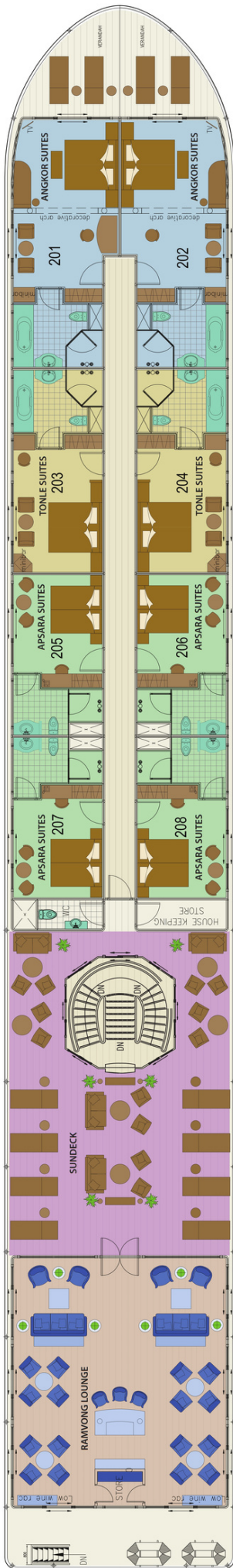
After breakfast, it's time to say goodbye and disembark the Mekong Princess in Ho Chi Minh City. Transfer is provided to a central hotel meeting point.



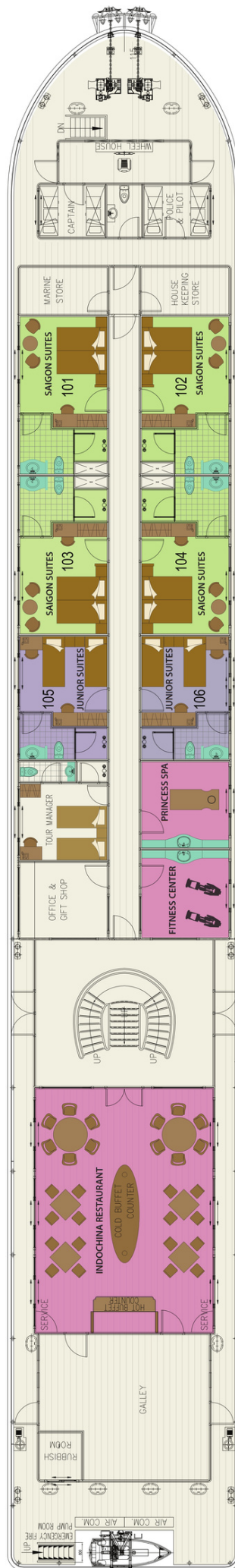
Your route Mekong Princess

All information contained in this brochure is correct at time of creation (27Apr23) with information provided by Viet Princess Cruises and is subject to change by the cruise line without notice. This brochure is produced by Cruise Traveller Australia.

Reservations, Payments & Documentation:

Mekong Princess requires an initial deposit of USD \$400 per person at the time of booking. Full payment is due no later than 90 days prior to departure. No change is permitted after final payment is received. Final documentation will be issued approximately 30 days prior to sailing, after final payment. All reservations are subject to cancellation if payments are not received by the deposit and final due date.

Cancellations & Changes

Mekong Princess requires all cancellations in writing. Cancellation fees are as follows:

- Cancel 91 days prior to sailing - deposit of USD \$400 pp is non-refundable
- Cancel 90 - 61 days prior to sailing - 50% of the total cruise fare pp is non-refundable.
- Cancel 60 - 0 days prior to sailing - 100% of the total cruise fare pp is non-refundable.

Changes to a booking after confirmation and deposit is paid may incur administration fees and a variation in fare price. Full name changes are considered cancellation. Changes are considered on a case by case basis and may result in loss of deposit or cancellation fees.
