With an average cruising speed of 8 knots (approximately 15km per hour) she affords a leisurely explore through a unique authentic part of the Mekong Delta.

The Mekong River is one of the longest rivers in the world, flowing approximately 4,350 kilometers (2,703 miles) through several countries in Southeast Asia.

The Mekong Delta, known as the "Rice Bowl" of Vietnam, is a vibrant region where the mighty Mekong River meets the South China Sea. This lush landscape is characterised by a maze of waterways, floating markets, and verdant rice paddies, making it one of the world's most fertile agricultural areas. The delta is home to diverse ecosystems, bustling communities, and a rich cultural tapestry, where traditional customs blend seamlessly with modern influences.

With only 14 Suites and a maximum 28 travellers it's truly a small boutique river vessel.

It has the highest crew to passenger ratio on the Mekong River at 30 crew to 28 passengers. Mekong Princess' crew who are known for their warmth and caring natures.

The only ship designed to go deep into the Mekong Delta, to show you the traditional lifestyle of the people and its beauty. Because of its size, being only two decks it can navigate the Saigon River, the Soai Rap river, Nuoc Man and Cho Gao Canals dug during the French colonial period, and the Van Co River, Mekong Princess is one of the only vessels that is capable of navigating these stunning areas, in addition to the mighty Mekong River.

The only river vessel licenced to tie-up overnight in the heart of the capital of the Mekong Delta, Can Tho with its fascinating night markets very near where the ship is docked.

DAY 1. Siem Reap

And we're off! Join the complimentary air conditioned motor-coach from a centrally located Siem Reap hotel to Kampong Cham where the Mekong Princess awaits you.

DAY 2. Angkor Ban & Phnom Penh

Start today with a blessing ceremony by local monks and a visit to the authentic Cambodian village of Angkor Ban. The local children join the fun with a visit to the school. Local cyclo drivers are waiting to take you for a ride through the busy streets to the Royal Palace and then on to the National Museum. Dinner is enhanced this evening with an Apsara dance. performance.

DAY 3. Phnom Penh

This morning, travel by private motor-coach, arriving at Choeung Ek, "The Killing Fields" - the centre of the darkest days of Cambodian history. There is an opportunity to walk through the fields, visit the small museum and Memorial Stupa. On return to Phnom Penh, you will visit the infamous S-21 - Tuol Sleng, a school turned into torture prison for enemies of the Khmer Rouge.

DAY 4. Border Crossing Hong Ngu & Gieng Island

Near the Cambodia-Vietnam border is the village of Hong Ngu. Your morning visit to the local weavers and artists in this rarely visited village is very welcome. In the afternoon board sampans to Gieng Island to a local village.

DAY 5. Hoa An & Can Tho

Wake to a sunrise at Hoa An village, known for flowers and crafts. See the gardens and meet the locals and learn about their daily lives. Continue on by motor cart to another village and learn how conical hats and mats are woven.

DAY 6. Can Tho & Ben Tre

Before breakfast, board sampans for a cruise through the fascinating Cai Rang floating market near Can Tho. On the way back to Mekong Princess, stop at a local noodle factory to witness the ancient art of noodle making.

DAY 7. Ben Tre & Ho Chi Minh City

Take a sampan through mangrove lined channels to visit a local coconut candy maker - so delicious! Then walk through the village to visit an orchard where native fruits grow on vines. The Mekong Princess will sail on through the Bassac River to Ho Chi Minh City here it will dock overnight at Saigon Port.

DAY 8. Ho Chi Minh City

After breakfast, it's time to say goodbye and disembark the Mekong Princess in Ho Chi Minh City. Transfer is provided to a central hotel meeting point.

The suite was named after Tonle Sap - the beating heart of the lower Mekong.

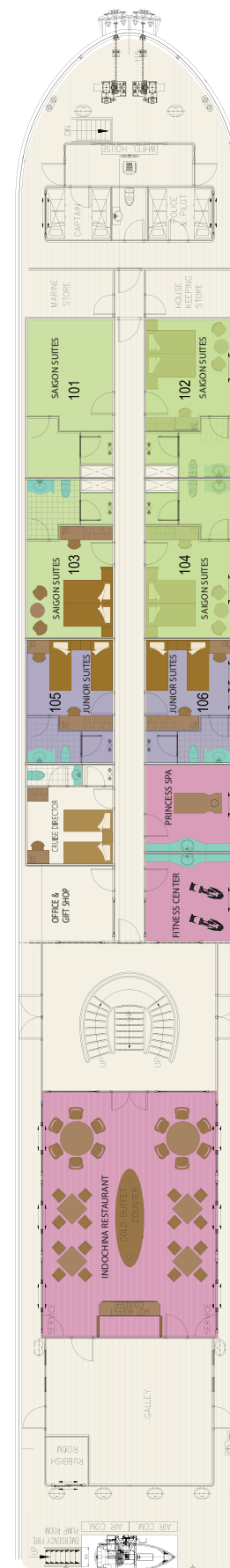
At 30 square metres, there's more to enjoy on these two Bassac Deck beauties.

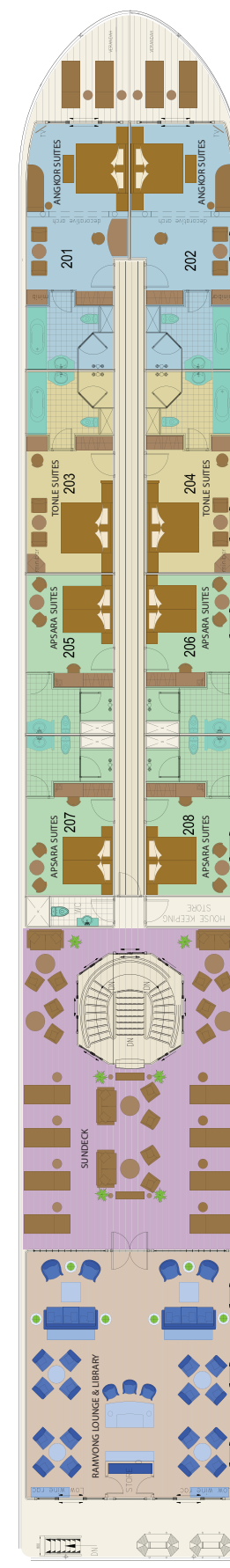


Mekong Princess Deck Plan

Full payment is due no later than 100 days prior to departure. No change is permitted after final payment is received. Final documentation will be issued approximately 30 days prior to sailing, after final payment. All reservations are subject to cancellation if payments are not received by the deposit and final due date.

Mekong Princess requires all cancellations in writing. Cancellation fees are as follows:

- Cancel 91 days prior to sailing - deposit of cruise portion of the package price is non-refundable.
- Cancel 90 - 61 days prior to sailing - 50% of the total cruise fare pp is non-refundable.
- Cancel 60 - 0 days prior to sailing - 100% of the total cruise fare pp is non-refundable.
- Changes to a booking after confirmation and deposit is paid may incur administration fees and a variation in fare price. Full name changes are considered cancellation. Changes are considered on a case by case basis and may result in loss of deposit or cancellation fees.
