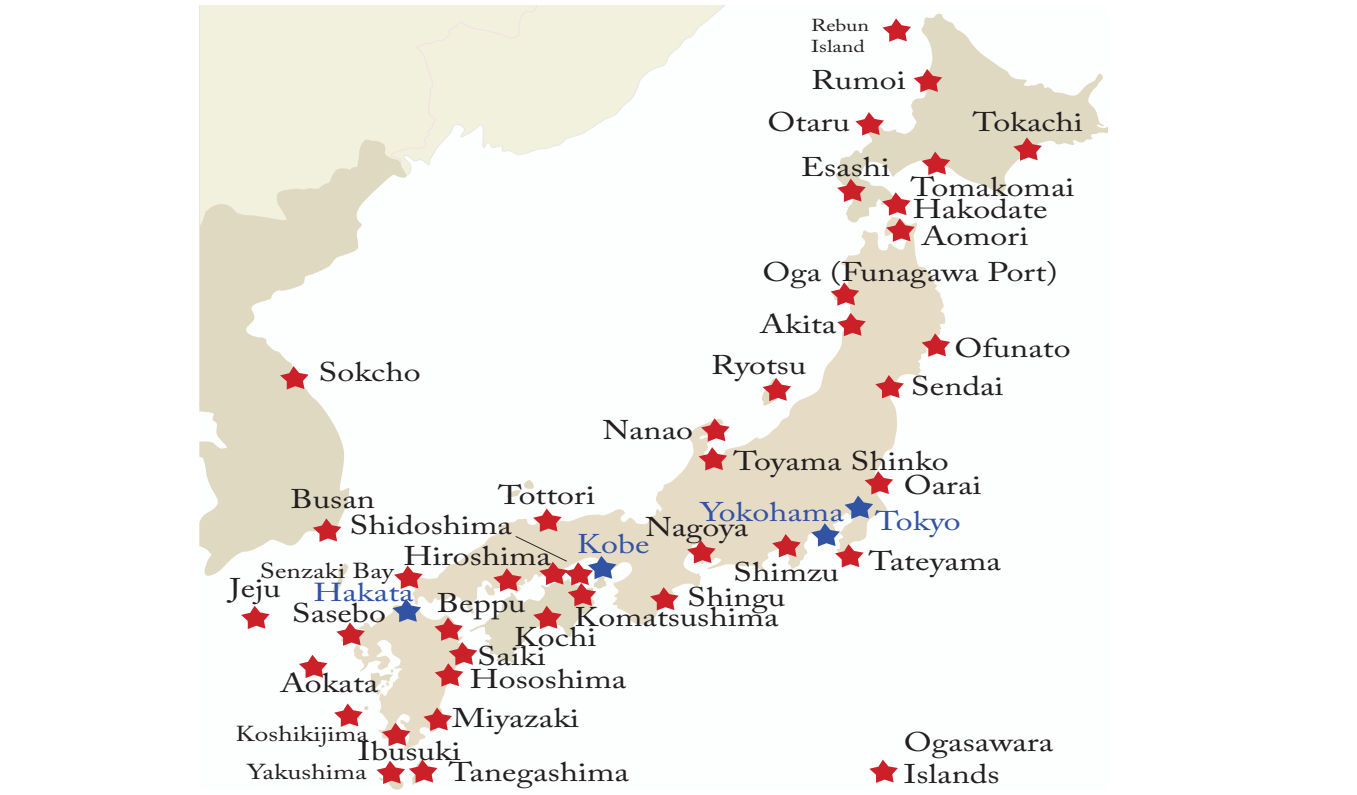

● Suites 652, 654, 656, 651, 653, 655, 925, and 1025 have partially obstructed views due to the ship's structure.

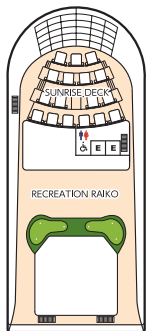
● Guests in forward cabins may experience loud noises during anchoring.

● Suites 502-507 and 745-746 have smaller balconies.

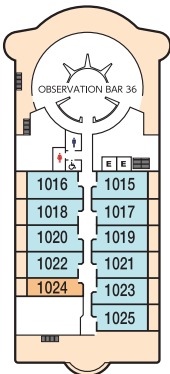

● All Suites (including balconies) are non-smoking. Please use the designated smoking area (center of Deck 9).

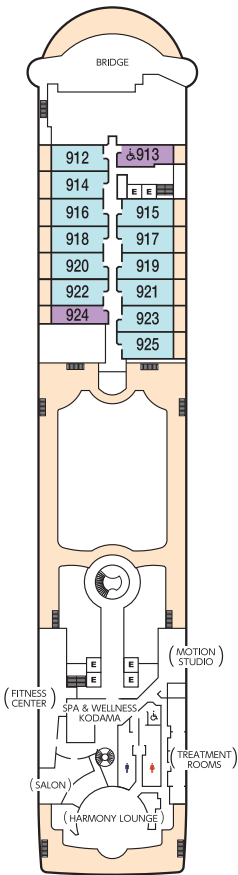
